1. Invite the Dad's along to your normal GB night.

3. Divide the Dad's and their daughters into teams of about 6-8
4. Give each of the groups a box containing recyclable items (ie: block of wood, empty boxes, margarine containers, cardboard cylinders, cereal boxes etc.) plus a roll of masking tape.
5. Each group then gets 30 minutes to build their 'mini golf hole'.
6. Once all holes have been created dad's and daughters move around each of the hole and play a round of golf.
